## Unity Is Possible (Part 2)

Unity is possible when people pay careful attention to the teaching of Jesus and are willing to die to themselves. Actively listening to Jesus means putting away my value filters, my opinions and my assumptions and totally fixing my eyes on the Lord. Loving the Lord means dying to self so we can live for Him (2 Cor. 5:14-15). People can and will see the Scriptures alike when they consciously die to themselves and truly regard Jesus as Lord in their hearts (1 Pet. 3:15). The body of Christ has but one head, and the body can be unified when every member submits to the head.

Unity is possible when brethren devote themselves more to the teaching of the biblical text than they do to their opinions, traditions or desires. The Lord's church is not a democratic republic where every person can vote on what we believe. The Lord's church is a kingdom with only one king, one lawgiver and one judge. We are slaves to our Lord and citizens to our King. When the King speaks, we listen instead of arguing with Him. The Lord's church has no first amendment when it comes to the commandments and instructions of God.

When challenged by some judaizing Christians who distorted the only gospel for a different gospel, Paul declared that such teachers are "accursed" (Gal. 1:8-90, "severed from Christ," and "fallen from grace" (5:4). What they believed mattered to the unity of the church; their error was a serious challenge to the purity of the church. Paul could not remain silent and allow a doctrinal error to attack the whole church. He believed brethren devoted to Christ could control their thinking and "adopt no other view" (vv. 7-10). When brethren allow error to go unchecked, one can be sure a more serious division is inevitable.

Some say unity of the faith is impossible because everyone approaches the Scriptures with their own biases and preconceived ideas. But is this the whole story? The glory and grandeur of Scripture and creation is that our free will allows us to put away erroneous notions and overcome our biases. Though Paul was sure John Mark was not suitable for his ministry in Acts 15:37-39, he found him to be useful to him for service in 2 Timothy 4:11.

To suggest we are so blind we are unable to remove prejudices and false assumptions that arise from our experiences is ultimately to deny that God has granted us the ability to learn, to repent or to change our hearts. We can test ourselves and our thinking. Are Paul's words impossible to keep? "But examine everything carefully; hold fast to that which is good; abstain from every form of evil" (1 Thess. 5:21-22).

Intellectual honesty requires us to admit our presuppositions and acknowledge our temptations to bias. While no one has absolute knowledge of all things but God, we are not mistaken or deceived when we affirm the things God affirms and deny the things God denies. By faith we can confidently say with Scripture we "know" certain truths to be correct (e.g., Rom. 8:28; 2 Cor. 5:1; Heb. 11:3; 1 John 5:13).
