## Abide In The Doctrine of Christ Nick Bartell

We as Christians have a charge to abide in the doctrine or teachings of Christ (2 John 9). This is important because John stated that “whosoever goes beyond and does not continue in the doctrine of Christ does not have God.” Therefore, it is imperative to those who want to please God to remain in Christ’s doctrine. With that in mind let us seek to better understand the teachings of the New Testament.

First, Christ revealed the doctrine. Jesus declared, “My doctrine is not mine, but His that sent Me” (John 7:16). Throughout His ministry Jesus constantly affirmed that He spoke what the Father gave Him to speak (John 8:28; 12:49-50; 14:24). The message which the Father committed unto Him forms the whole of which Jesus taught His disciples. Our King said, “I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received them” (John 17:8). Thus, Jesus only revealed the things which were given to Him.

Second, the Holy Spirit reinforced the doctrine. Jesus told His apostles that the Spirit would teach them all things, and bring all things to their remembrance, whatsoever He had said unto them (John 14:26; 16:13). This means that the Holy Spirit would help the apostles recall everything Jesus had taught them, which things He Himself received from the Father. Thus the Spirit only reinforced the things which were given to Him, the same things which Jesus had taught the people.

Third, apostles in turn relayed the doctrine. Jesus charged them to only teach things which He had commanded them (Mat. 28:18-20). Therefore, these men did not teach their own ideas and philosophies, but rather the things of God, which things our Lord revealed unto them, and the Spirit reinforced. Thus, the apostles only relayed the things which were given them from the Son and the Spirit, and in all reality the apostle’s doctrine and Christ’s doctrine are one and the same.

Finally, the church remained in the doctrine. After the kingdom was established on Pentecost, Luke wrote that believers “continued steadfastly in the apostle’s doctrine (Acts 2:42). We like the early church must abide in this doctrine. We do such by studying it (2 Tim. 2:15), using it as our standard (1 John 4:6), and growing therein (2 Pet. 3:18). When we do such we can be sure that we are in God, God is in us, and the hope of heaven is ours!’

### Parental Guidance

God knew that if children are not taught to respect parents in the home, they will not respect anyone. They will not respect teachers in the school, employers in the workplace, police officers in the community, or judges in the courts. Most importantly, they will not respect God Himself. That is why the Fifth Commandment says, “Honor your father and your mother” (Exodus 20:12; also Ephesians 6:2-3).

There are basically four kinds of parenting. (1) Soft Parenting. This kind of parenting has lots of love, but no limits (or boundaries). The parent is passive and lets the child do as he pleases. (2) Slack Parenting. This kind of parenting does not have much love or limits. The parent is neglectful and leaves the child to himself. (3) Strict Parenting. This kind of parenting does not have much love, but lots of limits. The parent is overbearing and rules the child with an iron fist. (4) Sound Parenting. This kind of parenting has lots of love and limits. The parent is balanced in his display of affection and enforcement of discipline. This is the proper kind of parenting.
