## MSOP Fall 2017 Campaigns

From October 29<sup>th</sup> thru November 3<sup>rd</sup>, the first and second year students, along with those enrolled in the missions program, participated in the annual fall campaigns. The student body was divided into four groups, with approximately a dozen in each group, each traveling to four different locations in order to assist the respective congregations in an evangelistic effort to reach the lost. Here are the details of each of the campaigns.

One group travelled to Lithia Springs, Georgia. A total of 3,554 doors were knocked resulting in six Bible studies, and 1 correspondence course. By the end of the campaign two precious souls were looking to be restored and one was baptized into Christ.

The second group travelled to Perry, Georgia. 2,032 doors were knocked resulting in 1 Bible study. To date there have been no baptisms. Although there were few visitors during the services, both local brethren and the students were encouraged by the preaching of God's word.

The third group travelled to Stowell, Texas. A total of 2,031 doors were knocked. The response there was good, with a total of 3 confirmed studies and 36 possible studies. Visitors attended the meeting each night.

The fourth group travelled to Rutherfordton, North Carolina. The students knocked doors in three communities: Rutherfordton, Ruth, and Spihdale. A total of 2,500 doors were knocked, resulting in one study with two young Mormons. Several promising contacts were made, but no visible fruit.

We appreciate the hard work that everyone put into the campaigns. We have planted the seed; now we pray that God will give the increase.
